

Statement on the use of cookies

We, Daimler Truck Financial Services Nederland B.V., use cookies and similar software tools such as HTML5 Storage or Local Shared Objects (together “cookies”) that are technically necessary to provide this website to you, including all of its functions and services that you use.

1. Functions and use of cookies

a. Cookies are small files that are placed on your desktop, notebook or mobile device by a website you visit. From this we can, for example, manage your selections in the online vehicle configurator, maintain your log-in status or manage your shopping cart (as relevant). Cookies may also contain personal data (such as a pseudonymous sequence of characters identifying your browsing session).

b. You can also visit our website without the use of cookies. This means that you can reject and delete cookies at any time by making the appropriate settings on your device. This is done as follows:

i. Most browsers are pre-set to automatically accept cookies. You can change this setting by activating the setting *do not accept cookies* in your browser.

ii. You can delete existing cookies at any time. You can find out how this works in detail in the instructions of your browser or device manufacturer.

iv. Like the use of cookies, their rejection or deletion is also linked to the device used and also to the browser used in each case. You must therefore reject or delete the cookies separately for each of your devices and, if you use several browsers, also for each browser.

c. If you decide against the use of cookies, it is possible that not all functions and services of our websites are available to you or that individual functions or services are only available to you to a limited extent.

2. List of cookies

We use the following cookies on our website:

| Name | Description | Storage period |

| _pk_id.<appID>.<domainHash> | Used to recognize visitors and hold their various properties | 13 months |
| _pk_cvar | Holds custom variables that were set during the previous page view | 30 min |
| app_id | Used to pass a site or app ID between Piwik PRO's modules: Analytics, Tag Manager, Audience Manager, Consent Manager, Administration. | 365 days |

| piwik_auth | Stores session information for Piwik PRO's user interface (UI). As long as this cookie is valid and contains a login and a token_auth parameter, a visitor is considered as a logged-in visitor, and a PIWIK_SESSID cookie will be refreshed | 24 min |
| PIWIK_SESSID | Stores a PHP session ID | 24 min |
| ppms_privacy_<appID> | Stores visitor's consent to data collection and usage | 365 days or 30 min (for anonymous tracking) |
| stg_traffic_source_priority | Stores the type of traffic source that explains how the visitor reached your website | 30 min |
| stg_last_interaction | Determines whether the last visitor's session is still in progress or a new session has started. | 365 days |
| stg_returning_visitor | Determines if the visitor has already been to your website — they are returning visitors. | 365 days |
| stg_fired_<appID> | Determines if the combination of a tag and trigger was fired during the current visitor's session. | Session |
| stg_utm_campaign | Stores a name of the campaign that directed the visitor to your website. | Session |
| stg_externalReferrer | Stores an URL of a website that referred a visitor to your website | Session |
